Wyler Family Foundation Donates Dodge Ram 4x4 for the Clinton / Bush Haiti Relief Effort

As a franchised [Cincinnati Dodge dealer](#), Jeff Wyler Dodge in Eastgate received an email via the National Automobile Dealers' Association of a direct appeal by former President Bill Clinton and the [Clinton / Bush Haiti Relief Fund](#) to assist in the acquisition of 100 four wheel drive pickup trucks from dealerships nationwide. The trucks are needed to immediately transport the food, water, medicine and other needed aid directly from the airport and shipyard facilities in Port -Au- Prince, Haiti out into the city and surrounding areas.

According to David Wyler, President of the [Jeff Wyler Automotive Family](#) "We couldn't stand by and allow the human suffering from this natural disaster to be compounded by the lack of reliable four wheel drive trucks to move the aid." The William J Clinton Foundation is coordinating the oceanic transport of these trucks from a centralized Florida location to the port in Haiti. Every Jeff Wyler dealership location will be collecting cash donations as well bottled water, non-perishable food items and toiletries in conjunction with the Haiti Relief effort. All items collected will be donated locally to the [Matthew: 25 Ministries](#) in Kenwood. A Send off party is planned for Saturday February 13, 2010 from 11- 1pm at the Jeff Wyler Eastgate Automall, food and refreshments will be served
